

It needs our constant care and protection to make sure it thrives in every direction.


Just like a child, it's playful too.

Give it trash, it doubles the score pollution and waste, it'll start to pour. For what we sow, the world will reply, echoes of waste below the sky.




Strong sneezes, like winds, it will blow.
